
FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF JAMES THOMSONE AND JANET JAMESONE


James Thomsone was born in about 1600 of Dalkeith, Midlothian, Scotland. James married Janet Jamesone 18 April 1621 in Inveresk. Janet was likely born in Inveresk. Only one other Jamesone was married in Inveresk. This was George Jameson, who married Marioune Thomson the year after Janet, on 19 October 1622. George may be Janet's brother, and Marioune may be James' sister.

James and Janet had the following children:

- 1. William, christened 28 July 1622 in Dalkeith.
- 2. (Male), christened 8 August 1623 in Dalkeith.
- *3. **Jenet** (Jonet), christened 19 September 1624 in Dalkeith; married John Henderson.



Baptism record for Jenet Thomsone in Dalkeith: "The 19 of September 1624, parentes James Thomson, Jonet Jamesoun ye bairne named Jonet."

- 4. Thomas, christened 8 June 1626 in Dalkeith.
- 5. Robert, christened 5 July 1627 in Dalkeith.
