

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF THOMAS WILSON AND AGNES GROZER

Thomas Wilson was born in about 1630 of Dalkeith, the son of George Wilsone and Bessie Johnstoun. Thomas married Agnes Grozer 26 January 1655 in Dalkeith.



Marriage record for Thomas Wilson and Agnes Grozer in Dalkeith:
"Desember 19, Thomas Wilsone & Agnes Grosert both in this parish gave up thair bands matrimoniell before the sessions prayid acording to order maried January 26 1655"

George and William Wilson were witnesses at the baptisms of Thomas' children, and Thomas was often a witness for their children. At the christening of George's daughter Margaret in 1655 the witnesses were *George Wilsone gatcher* or gutcher (a Scottish word for grandfather) and *Thomas Wilsone unkill* (uncle). So George and Thomas were the sons of George. William was also likely another brother.




Christening record for Margaret Wilson in Dalkeith in 1655:

Dalkeith Church


Thomas died and was buried 11 November 1713 in Dalkeith. Thomas' occupation is shown as tylor (tailor).

"Noveb 11th Thomas Wilson Tylor"

Thomas and Agnes had the following children:

- 1. **Janet**, (twin), christened 23 February 1656 in Dalkeith. (George Wilson and William Wilson were witnesses.)
- 2. **Thomas**, (twin) christened 23 February 1656 in Dalkeith. (George Wilson and William Wilson were witnesses.)
- 3. George, christened 14 May 1657 in Dalkeith. (George Wilson was a witness.)w
- *4. Margaret, christened 22 March 1660 in Dalkeith; married John McMillan.





FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF GEORGE WILSONE AND BESSIE JOHNSTOUN

George Wilsone was born in about 1590 of Dalkeith. He married Bessie Johnstoun.


Both George Wilsone and Bessie Johnstoun were mentioned in the will (testament dative) of Thomas Wilsoun, "walker at the walkmyln in Dalkeith" in 1614. A walker was a fuller. George and Bessie were mentioned in the debts owed to the deceased. No relationship between Thomas and George was mentioned.



From the testament dative of Thomas Wilsoun of Dalkeith, 1614: "Item be George Wilsone and Bessy Jonstoun the spouse" owed Thomas a debt of three pounds

George and Bessie had the following children:

1. **William**, christened 23 July 1616 in Dalkeith; married Jenet Gemill in 1642, and had children Jean, William, Archbald, Thomas and Janet.



Baptism record for William Wilsone in Dalkeith: "The 23 of July 1616 parentes George Wilsonn Bessie Jonstonn ye bairns name Wm Wilson. Witnesses Thomas Scher and greif George Simsonn"

- 2. Agnes, christened 18 November 1620 in Dalkeith.
- 3. **George**, born in about 1627 of Dalkeith, married Agnes Hereon or Howrin, and had children William, Margaret, Janet, Robert, George, Archibald, Alisone, and Elspeth.
- *4. **Thomas**, born in about 1630 of Dalkeith; married Agnes Grozer 26 January 1655 in Dalkeith; occupation: tailor; buried 11 November 1713 in Dalkeith.
