2. **Thomas Ignatius** was born January 13, 1913 in Chicago, Illinois. He graduated from the University of Nevada as a mining engineer. In World War II he served as a range and radar officer for the San Francisco harbor defense system, and helped set up the radar scanners that protected the Bay. He married Mary Nicholson (Nikky) 15 October 1942 in Fort Monroe, Virginia, and had no children. Thomas worked for PG&E as a senior design engineer. He died December 1, 1966.

Marriage record for Thomas Carey and Mary Nicholson in Ft. Monroe, Virginia

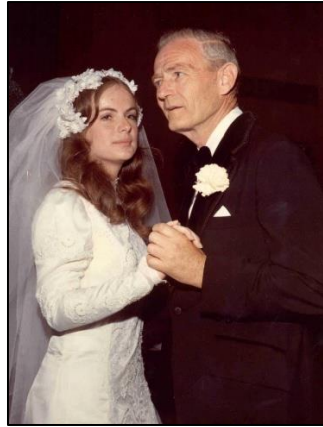


Thomas Carey, 1955

He served as an artillery spotter in World War II, and received the Bronze Star for bravery. He married Beulah Green, and had four children: Charles, Alice, Raymond, and William. Jim worked for the Bank of America as a computer research consultant, and played a pioneering role in establishing computer systems for the bank. He died October 22, 1992, in San Francisco.
