


FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF RYCHARD AND ALES LECHE

Rychard Leche was born in about 1490 of Wardington. He married Ales.

Rychard died in 1548, leaving a will.



Will of Rychard Leche of Warmington, 1548

In the name of God Amen the xj day of October yn the yere of owre lorde God 1548 I Rychard Leche of the paryshe of Warmyngton withyn the conte of Warwick & dyocsyce of Lychfelde & Coventre syke in body but holle in mynd & of goode memory ordere & make thys my laste wylle & testament yn manner & forme follooyng. Fyrste I bequethe my sole unto allmyghte God & my body to be buryd in the parishe church yarde at Warmyngton & I gyve unto the same church ijs iiijd. Item I gyve unto the hy alter there iiijd & to the mother churche ijd. Item I gyve unto Izabell my daughter viij ewes & unto Anes my dowghters chylderne evry one a shype & unto Rychard hyre sone my carte. All the reste of my other goodes unbequethyde my dettes payd & my body hownestely brought howme I gyve unto Ales my wiffe. Also I ordere & make John Petefere my sone in lawe my solle executor to se thys my laste wylle performyd & I gyve unto hym for hys labore ijs iiijd. Beyng wyttenes thereunto Symon Pope parson John Hynes Gylles Perkyns & Wylyam Archere with others.




Ales died in 1553, leaving a will.



Will of Ales Leche of Warmington, 1553

In dei noie anno the yere of owre lorde God 1553 & the xvijth day of Marche I **Ales Leche of the parishe of Warmyngton** within the counte of Warwyke & diocece of Lichfeild & Coventre syke in body but helteyn mynde & of good and good memory order and make thys my last wylle & testament yn manner & forme following Fyrste I bequeth my sole to allmyghtie God the Fathere & to hys sone awre lord Jesus Christ by the merites of whose passion I truste freely to be forgiven of my synnes & my body to be buryde withyn the parishe churche yarde of Warmyngton. Item I gyve unto the poremens chest there xijd. Item I gyve unto **Elzabet Daves my daughter** too kyrtelles & to hyr husbande the beste hyve of bees save on that I have & to hyr dawghter **Ales Alstell** brase potte. Item all the reste of my othere goodes unbequethyde I gyve unto **John Pettefere my sone yn lawe** whom I order & make my sole executor to se thys my last wylle performyd my dettes payd & my body honestly browght whom.
