

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF RICHARD AND MARY HARDY

No christening record has been found for Charity Hardy in and around East Markham, Derbyshire, but there is one family of Hardys having children in the right time period in the area. There is a family of Hardys in the parish of Gamston. Gamston is a parish in Derbyshire about three miles from East Markham, where Charity married John Moss.

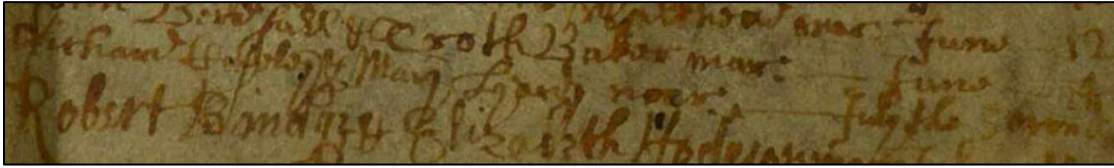
Richard was born in about 1640 of Gamston, Derbyshire, near Retford. He married Mary.

Richard died and was buried 19 April 1673 in Gamston.

Mary married again just three months later to Richard Caseley 2 July 1673 in Tuxford, Derbyshire.

Richard and Mary (Hardy) had the following children:

1. **John**, christened 27 August 1665 in Gamston.
2. **Mary**, christened 22 March 1666 in Gamston; buried 20 January 1682 in Gamston.
- *3. **Charity**, born in about 1670; married John Moss 14 August 1692 in East Markham.
