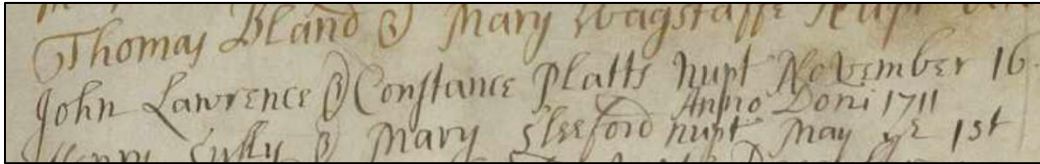


## FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF JOHN LAWRENCE AND CONSTANCE PLATTS

No christening record has been found for Alice Lorrans, but the only Lorrans/Lawrence family in East Markham having children in the right time period were John and Constance Lawrence. John Lawrence was christened 12 January 1686 in Bothamsall, Nottinghamshire, the son of Joshua Lawrence and Anne Watkins. He married Constance Platts 16 November 1710 in Rampton, Nottinghamshire. Constance was the daughter of Richard and Prudence Platts.



*Marriage record for John Lawrence and Constance Platts in Rampton:  
"John Lawrence & Constance Platts nupt November 16"*

Their children were christened in East Markham and West Drayton, about two miles away.

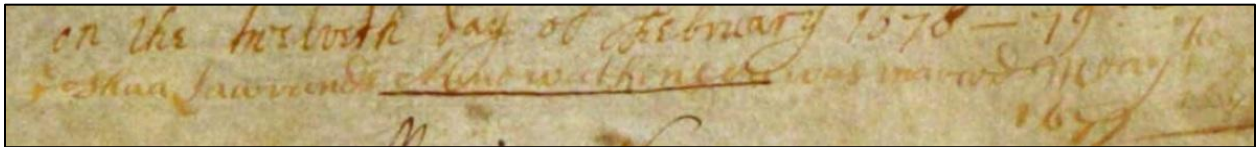
John and Constance had the following children:

1. **Thomas**, christened 22 April 1710 in West Drayton, Nottinghamshire.
2. **John**, christened 25 May 1712 in East Markham.
3. **Constans** (female), christened 23 August 1714 in East Markham.
4. **Elizabeth**, christened 6 December 1716 in East Markham.
- \*5. **Alice**, born in about 1719 of East Markham; married Joseph Hemsell 15 November 1741 in East Markham; buried 13 February 1773 in East Markham.
6. **Joshuah**, christened 1719 in West Drayton.
7. **Ann**, christened 24 March 1720 in West Drayton.
8. **Thomas**, christened 19 April 1724 in East Markham.
9. **Joseph**, christened 19 April 1724 in East Markham (possible twins).

## FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF JOSHUA LAWRENCE AND ANNE WATKINS

Joshua Lawrence was christened 25 January 1655 in Edwinstowe, Nottinghamshire, the son of Richard and Margaritt Lawrance. Richard was shown as being of Budby, a hamlet in the parish of Edwinstowe, about four miles southeast of Bothamsall, Nottinghamshire at Joshua's christening. Joshua married Anne Watkins 22 May 1679 in Bothamsall.



*Marriage record for Joshua Lawrence and Anne Watkins in Bothamsall:  
"Josua Lawrands & Anne Watkenes was married May the 22 1679"*

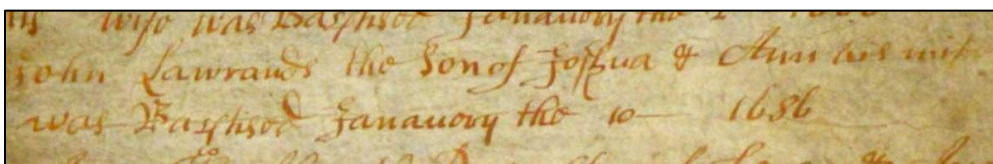


*Bothamsall*

Joshua died and was buried 29 April 1695 in Bothamsall.

Joshua and Anne had the following children:

1. **Joshuah**, christened 30 January 1680 in Bothamsall; buried 11 March 1680 in Bothamsall.
2. **Elizabeth**, christened 26 March 1682 in Bothamsall; buried 10 December 1682 in Bothamsall.
- \*3. **John**, christened 12 January 1686 in Bothamsall; married Constance Platts 16 November 1710 in Rampton, Nottinghamshire.



*Baptism record for John Lawrence in Bothamsall: "John Lawrands the son of Joshua & Ann his wife was baptised Janauory the 10 1686"*

4. **Margaret**, christened 6 February 1688 in Bothamsall.

5. **Richard**, (possibly twins) christened 6 February 1688 in Bothamsall; married Elizabeth Theaker 1 May 1714 in Bothamsall.

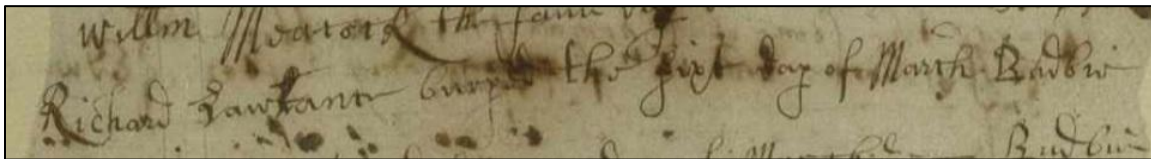
### **FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF RICHARD AND MARGARITT LAWRENCE**

Richard Lawrence was born in about 1630 of Edwinstowe, Nottinghamshire. He married Margaritt. Richard was shown as being of the hamlet of Budby in the parish of Edwinstowe in the christening of his son Joshua.



*Budby*

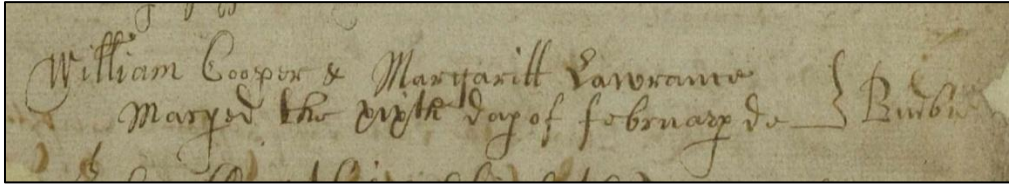
Richard died and was buried 1 March 1658 in Edwinstowe. He was shown as being of Budby at the time of his death. Richard's son Joshua was only three years old when Richard died.



*Burial record for Richard Lawrence in Edwinstowe:  
"Richard Lawrence buried the first day of March Budby"*

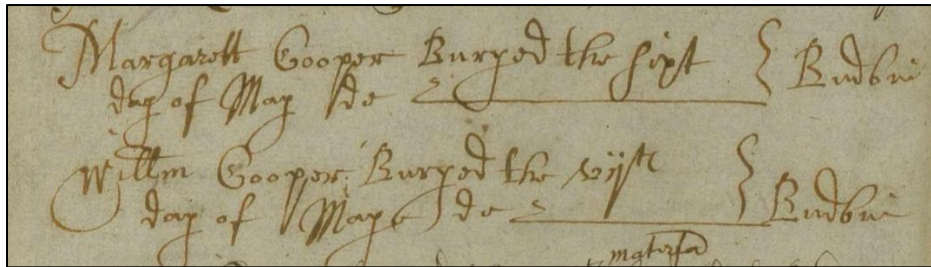
Margaritt married again two years later, to William Cooper of Budby on 19 February 1660 in

Edwinstowe.



*Marriage record for William Cooper and Margarit Lawrance in Edwinstowe:  
"William Cooper & Margaritt Lawrance maryed the sixth day of February de - Budbie"*

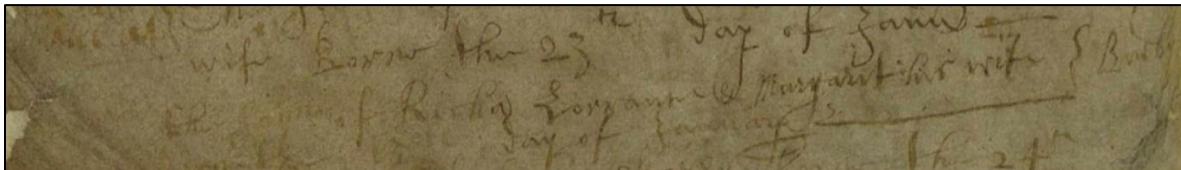
Margaritt died and was buried just two years later on 1 May 1662 in Edwinstowe. She was shown as being of Budby at the time of her death. William Cooper of Budby died and was buried just six days later, on 7 May 1662. Joshua was only seven years old when his mother and step-father died.



*Burial record for Margarit Cooper in Edwinstowe:  
"Margarett Cooper buryed the first day of May de - Budbie  
Willm Cooper buryed the vijth day of May de - Budbie"*

Richard and Margaritt had the following child:

\*1. **Joshua**, christened 25 January 1655 in Edwinstowe; married Anne Watkins 22 May 1679 in Bothamsall; buried 29 April 1695 in Bothamsall.



*Baptism record for Joshua Lawrence in Edwinstowe: "Joshua the sonne of Richard Lorraine & Margarit his wife was borne the 25 day of January - Budby"*
