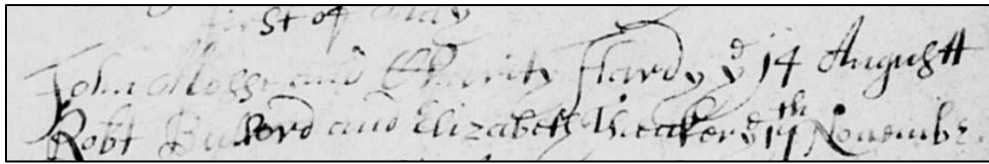


FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF JOHN MOSS AND CHARITY HARDY

John Moss was christened 17 June 1667 in East Markham, Nottinghamshire, the son of Jane Moss. (His christening record was extracted as John, the illegitimate son of James Moss, however a careful examination of the record shows that he was the son of Jane Moss. This makes more sense as the mother is usually mentioned in the christening record of an illegitimate child, and not the father.)

John married Charity Hardy 14 August 1692 in East Markham. His occupation was roper (ropemaker). Charity was most likely the daughter of Richard and Mary Hardy of the nearby parish of Gamston.

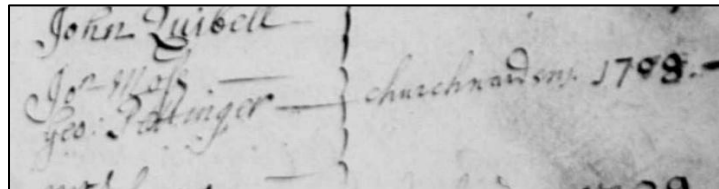


*Marriage record for John Moss and Charity Hardy in East Markham:
"John Mosse and Charity Hardy ye 14 Augustt"*

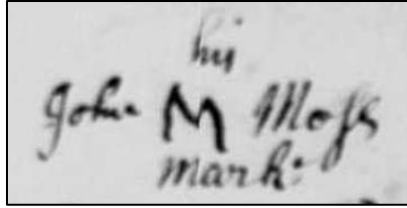


East Markham

John Moss was a churchwarden in East Markham in 1708.

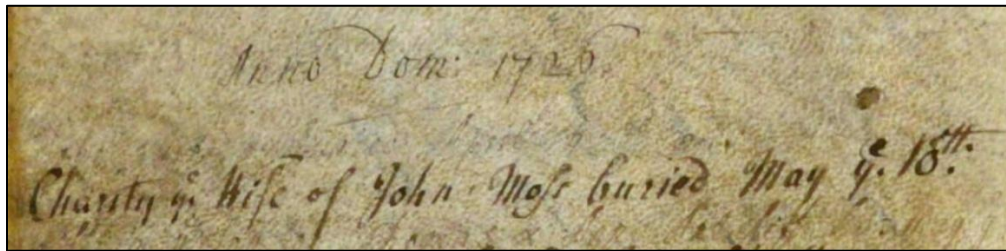


John Moss, churchwarden, 1708

John was an overseer for the poor in 1700*

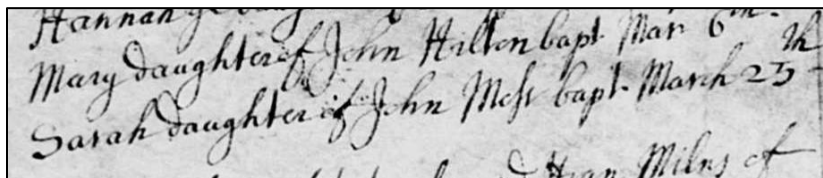
Charity died and was buried 18 May 1726 in East Markham.



*Burial record for Charity Moss in East Markham:
"Anno Domini: 1726 Charity ye wife of John Moss buried May ye 18th"*

John and Charity had the following children:

1. **John**, christened 24 March 1694 in East Markham.
2. **William**, christened 13 February 1696 in East Markham.
3. **Charity**, christened June 1699 in East Markham.
- *4. **Sarah**, christened 25 March 1700 in East Markham, Nottinghamshire; married Joseph Hempell 10 August 1716 in East Markham.



Baptism record for Sarah Moss in East Markham: "Sarah daughter of John Moss bapt March 23"

5. **James**, christened 17 March 1703 in East Markham; married Ann Denman 11 May 1723 in West Markham; occupation - husbandman.

6. **Mary**, christened 18 December 1705 in East Markham.

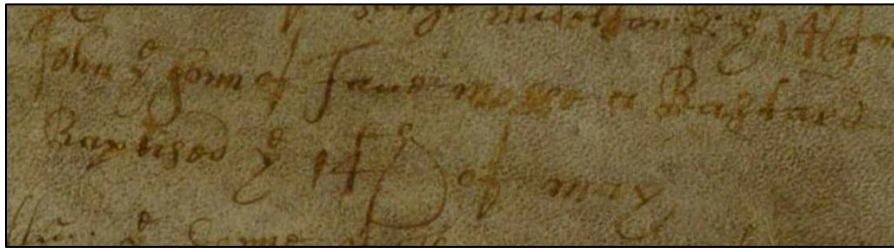

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF JANE MOSS

Jane Moss was christened 16 November 1643, the daughter of William Mosse and Elizabeth Cooke.

At age 24, Jane was the mother of an illegitimate son:

*1. **John**, christened 14 May 1667 in East Markham; married Charity Hardy 14 August 1693 in East Markham.

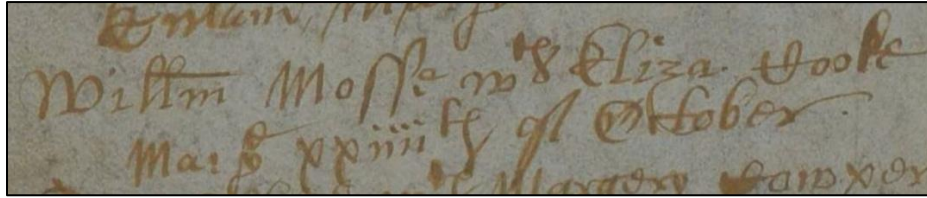


*Baptism record for John Moss in East Markham:

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF WILLIAM MOSSE AND ELIZABETH COOKE

William Mosse was christened 25 September 1603, the son of William Mosse and Elizabeth Grene. He married Elizabeth Cooke 24 October 1625 in East Markham.

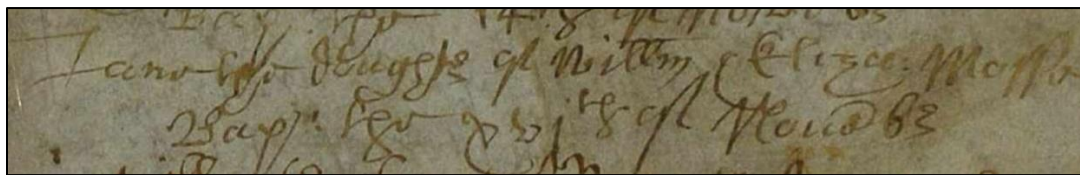


*Marriage record of William Mosse and Elizabeth Cooke in East Markham:

Elizabeth was christened 21 January 1610 in East Markham, the daughter of William Cooke, a yeoman of East Markham, and Elizabeth Smyth.

William and Elizabeth had the following children:

1. **William**, christened 29 April 1628 in East Markham.
2. **Ane**, christened 26 December 1630 in East Markham.
3. **Elizabeth**, christened 23 December 1632 in East Markham.
4. **Thomas**, christened 26 February 1634 in East Markham.
5. **Wynifride**, christened 4 March 1637 in East Markham.
6. **Margrett**, christened 28 May 1640 in East Markham.
- *7. **Jane**, christened 16 November 1645 in East Markham.



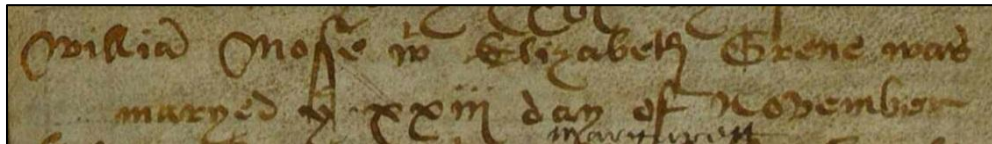
Baptism record for Jane Mosse in East Markham: "Jane the daughter of Willm & Eliza Mosse bap the xvijth of November"

8. **Frances**, christened 8 March 1648 in East Markham.

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF WILLIAM MOSSE AND ELIZABETH GRENE

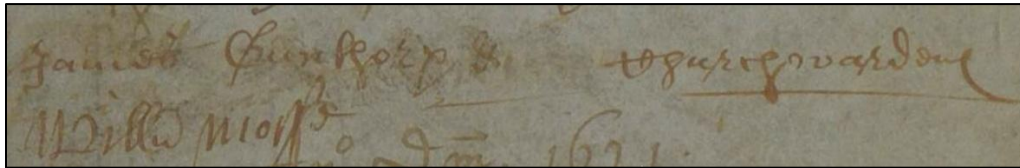
William Mosse was christened 22 January 1576 in East Markham, the son of Cuthbert Mosse and Sence Crane. He married Elizabeth Grene 23 November 1599 in East Markham.

Elizabeth was christened 2 April 1581 in East Markham, the daughter of Robert Grene.

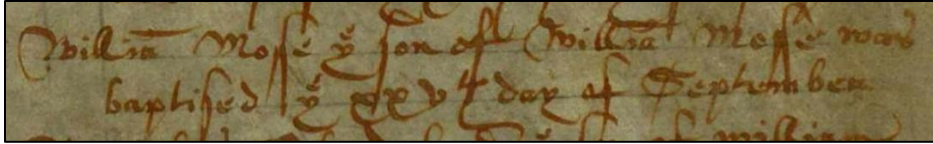
William was a churchwarden in East Markham in 1620.

William and Elizabeth had the following children:

1. **John**, christened 24 June 1597 in East Markham.
2. **Sythe**, christened 30 March 1600 in East Markham.
- *3. **William**, christened 25 September 1603 in East Markham.

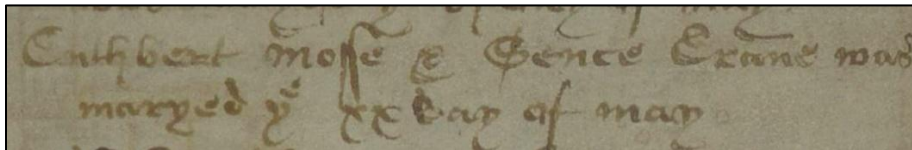


Baptism record for William Mosse in East Markham: "William Mosse ye son of William Mosse was baptised ye xxvth day of September"

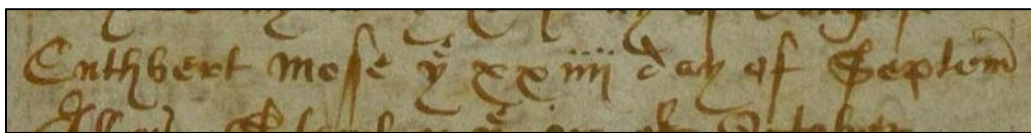
FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF CUTHBERT MOSSE AND SENCE CRANE

Cuthbert Mosse was born in about 1550 of East Markham. Cuthbert married Sence Crane 20 May 1571.

"Cuthbert Mosse & Sence Crane was maryed ye xx day of May"*

Cuthbert died and was buried 24 September 1586 in East Markham.



*Burial record for Cuthbert Mosse in East Markham:
"Cuthbert Mosse ye xxiiij day of Septem"*

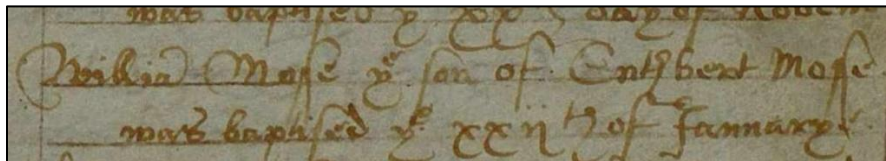
Sence died as a widow and was buried 15 October 1601 in East Markham.

"Sence Mosse widow was buried ye xvth of Oct"*

Cuthbert and Sence had the following children:

1. **Joane**, christened 9 March 1572 in East Markham.
2. **Margerye**, christened 13 July 1573 in East Markham.
- *3. **William**, christened 22 January 1576 in East Markham; married Elizabeth Grene 23 November 1599 in East Markham.



Baptism record for William Mosse in East Markham: "William Mosse ye son of Cuthbert Mosse was baptised ye xxijth of January"

4. **Robert**, christened 13 March 1579 in East Markham; married Beatrice Woodhouse 16 July 1600 in East Markham; buried 1629 in East Markham.
5. **James**, christened 9 December 1581 in East Markham; married Ann Raynes 20 November 1600 in East Markham; buried 1636 in East Markham.
6. **Anne**, christened 3 October 1584 in East Markham.
