
FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF RICHARD AND PRUDENCE PLATTS

Richard Platts was christened 20 April 1668 in Perlethorpe, Nottinghamshire son of Mathew Platts. Perlethorpe is about twelve miles from Rampton, Nottinghamshire. He married Prudence.

Prudence, the wife of Richard Platts was buried 15 July 1728 in Rampton.



Burial record for Prudence Platts in Rampton: "Prudence the wife of Richd Platts - July 15th"

Richard died and was buried 2 March 1730 in Rampton.



Burial record for Richard Platts in Rampton:
"Richard Platts buried - March ye 2nd"

Richard and Prudence had the following children:

- * 1. Constance, born in about 1690 of Rampton; married John Lawrance 16 November 1710 in Rampton.
- 2. Mary, christened 6 November 1693 in Rampton; married William Smith 1 May 1726 in Rampton.
- 3. **Anne**, christened 17 February 1696 in Rampton.


- 4. Elizabeth, christened 25 December 1698 in Rampton; buried 11 April 1718 in Rampton.
- 5. William, buried 17 September 1710 in Rampton.

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF MATHEW PLATTS

Mathew Platts was christened 1 May 1628 in Perlethorpe, the son of Nicholas Platts and Joyse Fisher. The name is shown as Platts, Platt, Plats and Plate in parish records.

Mathew died and was buried 27 April 1709 in Perlethorpe.



Burial record for Mathew Platts in Perlethorpe: "Matthew Plats was buried April 27"

Mathew and his wife had the following children:

- 1. Mathew, christened 17 August 1662 in Perlethorpe.
- 2. William, christened 12 December 1665 in Perlethorpe.
- *3. Richard, christened 20 April 1668 in Perlethorpe; married Prudence.



FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF NICHOLAS PLATTS AND JOYSE FISHER

Nicholas Platts was christened 3 July 1594 in Perlethorpe. No parents were listed in the christening records at this time, but William Platts and Anne Stamforde were the only Platts having children in Perlethorpe in 1604 when William was listed as the father of Katherine.



Baptism record for Nicholas Platts in Perlethorpe: "Nicholas Platts was babtysed the third of July"

Nicholas was mentioned in the will of Nicholas Rossell of Perlethorpe in 1597: "To my godson Nicholas Platts xijd."

Nicholas married Joyse Fisher 22 May 1627 in Perlethorpe.




Marriage record for Nicholas Platts and Joyse Fisher:
"Nicholas Platts and Joyse Ffisher was maried the 22th day of May anno predicto
(the year above mentioned)"

Nicholas and Joyse had the following children:

- 1. **Ann**, christened 28 May 1628 in Perlethorpe.
- 2. **Alice**, christened 29 August 1630 in Perlethorpe; married Thomas Rooseley 25 April 1667 in East Markham, Nottinghamshire, shown as "of Perlethorpe".

*3. Mathew, christened 1 May 1633 in Perlethorpe.

"Bap. Mattheus Platts filius Nicholai Plats baptizatus fuit primo die Maij Anno predicto 1633" (Translation: Mathew Platts son of Nicholas Platts was baptized the first day of May in the year above mentioned 1633)

- 4. Mary, christened 15 June 1636 in Perlethorpe.
- 5. Elisabeth, christened 21 July 1639 in Perlethorpe.
- 6. William, christened 17 September 1643 in Perlethorpe.

FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF WILLIAM PLATTS AND ANNE STAMFORDE

William Platts was born in about 1560 of Perlethorpe. He married Anne Stamforde 5 November 1587 in Perlethorpe.



Marriage record for William Platts and Anne Stamforde in Perlethorpe: "Wm Plattes and Anne Stamforde were married ye vth daie of November"

William was mentioned in the will of Katheryne Linfurthe of Perlethorpe in 1593, along with Rychard Platts. William was named as an executor for the will. Rychard was also mentioned in the will of Thomas Linfurth the same year.

William and Anne had the following children:

- *1. Nicholas, christened 3 July 1594 in Perlethorpe; married Joyse Fisher 22 May 1627 in Perlethorpe.
- 2. **Jane**, christened 18 December 1597 in Perlethorpe; married Densill Hayes 5 October 1621 in Perlethorpe.
- 3. **Richard**, born in about 1599 of Perlethorpe; buried 15 June 1664 in Perlethorpe.
- 4. **Katherine**, christened 12 February 1604; buried 23 February 1604 in Perlethorpe.
