
FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF WILLIAM SMALLEY

Malynn Smalley was christened 2 May 1560 in Beeston, Nottinghamshire. The parents' names were not recorded in the parish registers in the mid-to-late 1500s, but William Smalley was recorded as a churchwarden from 1563-1591, and was the only adult Smalley in the records at that time. William was likely Malynn's father. The pattern of births/christenings is typical of a single family.



Beeston

William Smalley was a churchwarden in the parish registers yearly from 1561 to 1591. His name was written at the end of each year, along with the other churchwarden, Richard Levis, and the vicar.



William was last listed as a churchwarden in 1598, when he signed his mark.

William Smalley was a churchwarden in 1598 and signed with his mark. This was the last year he was a churchwarden. "Examined by us W. Jeffreis vic. Rich. Levis, Wm Smalley} churchwardens"

William died and was buried 8 December 1630 in Beeston.

William and his wife had the following children:

1. Thomas, born about 1558; married Hellen Grannger 2 August 1580.

*2. Malynn, christened 2 May 1560 in Beeston; married Robert Kirckbee 3 November 1588 in Beeston.

- 3. Constance, christened 25 July 1563 in Beeston; married Richard Levis 15 May 1594 in Beeston.
- 4. Emmat, christened 28 December 1565 in Beeston; married Robert Foster 3 February 1595 in Beeston.
- 5. William, christened 30 May 1568 in Beeston; married Issabell Kirckbie 3 November 1588 in Beeston.

6. Agnes, christened 26 December 1570 in Beeston.
