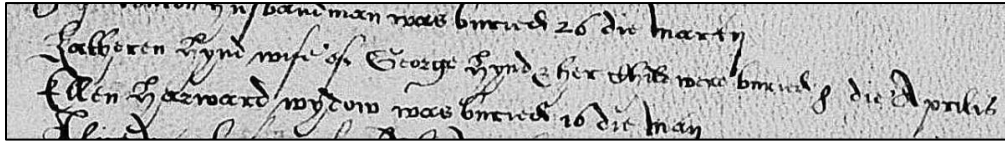


FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF GEORGE AND EMME HYND

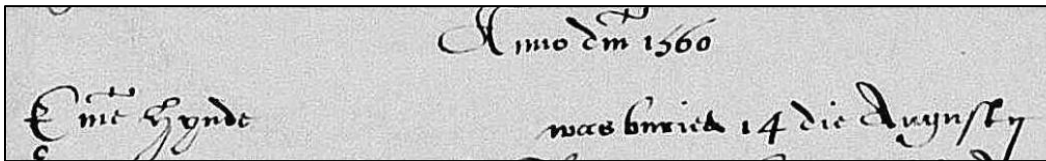
George Hynd was born in about 1520 of Bishops Tachbrook, Warwickshire, England. He married 1) Katheren.

Katheren "wife of George Hynd and her child" died and were buried 8 April 1545 in Bishops Tachbrook.



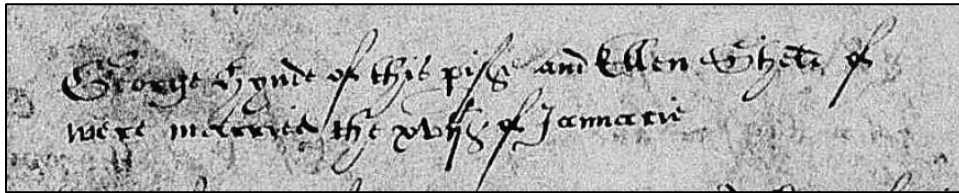
*Burial record for Katheren Hynd in Bishops Tachbrook:
"Katheren Hynd wife of George Hynd & her child were buried 8 die Aprilis"*

George married 2) Emme. Emme died and was buried 14 August 1560 in Bishops Tachbrook.



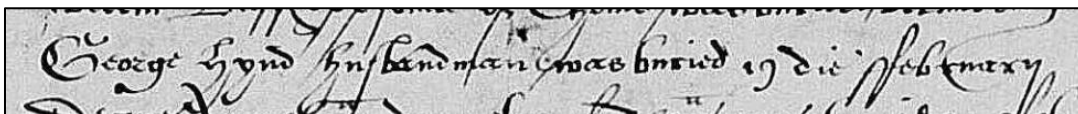
*Burial record for Emme Hynd in Bishops Tachbrook:
"Emme Hynde ___ was buried 14 die Augustij"*

George then married Ellen Sheld or Shets 17 January 1561 in Bishops Tachbrook.



*Marriage record for George Hynd and Ellen Shets in Bishops Tachbrook:
"George Hynde of this pische and Ellen Shets of ___ were married the xvijth of Jannarie"*

George died and was buried 19 February 1581 in Bishops Tachbrook.



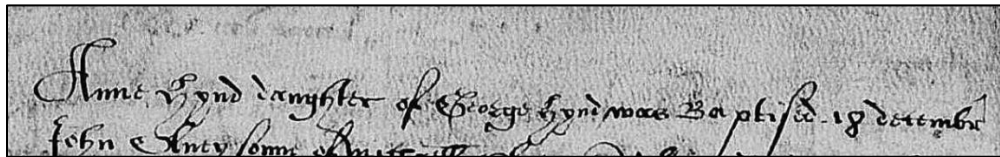
*Burial record for George Hynd in Bishops Tachbrook:
"George Hynd husbandman was buried 19 die ffebruary"*

George and Katheren had the following children:

1. **John**, christened 14 October 1541 in Bishops Tachbrook. A child, the son of George Hynd was buried 26 October 1545, and may have been John.
2. **Henrie**, christened 12 February 1546 in Bishops Tachbrook.

George and Emme had the following children:

3. **John**, christened 22 May 1547 in Bishops Tachbrook, may have died young.
4. **John**, christened 1 August 1548 in Bishops Tachbrook, may have died young.
5. **Jane**, christened 30 November 1549 in Bishops Tachbrook.
6. **William**, christened 13 December 1551 in Bishops Tachbrook. This is likely the William Hind who acted as an overseer for Peter Aston, his brother-in-law.
- *7. **Anne**, christened 18 December 1554 in Bishops Tachbrook; married Peter Aston 15 January 1583 in Bishops Tachbrook.



Baptism record for Anne Hynd in Bishops Tachbrook: "Anne Hynd daughter of George Hynd was baptised 18 Decembr"

8. **John**, christened 1 April 1558 in Bishops Tachbrook.

George and Ellen had the following children:

9. **Richard**, christened 10 August 1561 in Bishops Tachbrook.
10. **Joan**, christened 24 February 1562 in Bishops Tachbrook.
11. **Maria**, christened 1 January 1564 in Bishops Tachbrook; buried 11 January 1564 in Bishops Tachbrook.
