
## FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF RICHARD ASTON AND ELIZABETH ELLETE

No christening record has been found for Rose Aston, who married Gregory Greene in Moreton Morrell. The Astons are not a Moreton Morrell family, but a large family of Astons are found about four miles north in the neighboring parish of Bishops Tachbrook. This is most likely Rose's family.

Richard Aston was christened 31 June 1589 in Bishops Tachbrook (or Tachbrook), Warwickshire, England, the son of Peter and Anne Aston. Richard Aston of Tachbrook married Elizabeth Ellete of Wootton 8 July 1620 in Bishops Tachbrook.



Marriage record for Richard Aston and Elizabeth Ellete in Bishops Tachbrook: "Ric Aston of Tachbroke & Elyzabete Ellete of Woottan weare maryed the viijth of July"

Elizabeth was christened 1 November 1592 in Wootton Wawen, Warwickshire, the daughter of William Ellyottes.

Richard and Elizabeth had the following children:

- 1. Wyllyam, christened 11 November 1621 in Bishops Tachbrook.
- \*2. **Rose**, born in about 1630 of Bishops Tachbrook; married Gregory Greene 7 March 1659 in Moreton Morrell, Warwickshire.
- 3. Frances, christened 16 March 1633 in Bishops Tachbrook.


## FAMILY GROUP RECORD OF PETER ASTON AND ANNE HYND

Peter Aston was christened 1 November 1556 in Bishops Tachbrook, the son of Roger Aston.



Bishops Tachbrook


Peter married Anne Hynd 15 January 1583 in Bishops Tachbrook. Peter was a husbandman and tailor.

of Roger George Hynd of the same parishe 15 the January"


Anne was christened 18 December 1554 in Tachbrook, the daughter of George and Emme Hynd.

"Peter Aston husbandman was buryed the xith of May"


Peter left a will dated 26 July 1605:

In the name of God Amen the xth day of Maie in the yeare of our Lord God 1605, I **Peter Aston of Tachbroke** in the county of Warwick tealer sicke in body yet God be thanked of Good & perfett remembrannce do make this my last will & testament in maner & forme following first I geve & bequeth my soule into the handes of allmightie God my creator and redemer & my body to be buryed in Christen buryall.

First I geve unto the Church of Tachbroke iijs iiijd. Item I geve unto poore of Tachbroke vjs viijd to be devided by my overseers. Item I geve unto **Jone Aston my dowghter** xxv li of good & lawfull englis money to be payd unto her ijth yeares after my decease. Item I geve **Jane Aston my second dowghter** xxvth li of good & lawfull money of England to be payd unto her within ijth yeares after my decease. The rest of my goodes my dettes payd & my legasies fulfilled I geve them unto **Anne Aston my wife** & **Ric Aston my sonne** to be equally devided between them by the discretion of my overseers. Item I ordeyne and apoynt **Anne Aston & Ric Aston** my full & lawfull executors of this my last will & testament theise to be my overseers Wyllyam Hynd Thomas Maisters



- \*4. Richard, christened 31 June 1589 in Tachbrook.





Roger Aston was born in about 1525 of Bishops Tachbrook. He married Ellen. Roger was a tailor.


Ellen died and was buried 22 Apr 1559 in Tachbrook.

Roger then married Ales (Alice) Bowdell 20 January 1559 in Tachbrook. Ales died and was buried 5 June 1590 in Tachbrook.


Roger died and was buried 21 May 1596 in Tachbrook.

- 6. Joan, christened 13 September 1554 in Tachbrook.
- \*7. **Peter**, christened 1 November 1556 in Tachbrook; married Anne Hynd 15 January 1583 in Tachbrook; buried 11 May 1605 in Tachbrook.
