## THE FAMILY OF THOMAS BOWMAN AND MARTHA HORTON STOUT

Thomas Bowman was born 3 February 1803 in New Jersey, the son of Nicholas Bowman. He married Martha Horton Stout 13 March 1833 in Morris County, New Jersey. Thomas' occupation was a cordwainer or shoemaker.

Martha was born 15 February 1814 in Chester, Morris County, New Jersey, the daughter of Thomas Bryant Stout and Deborah Terry.

Thomas and Martha had the following children:

- 1. Rachel Elizabeth, born 28 March 1834 in Morris County.
- 2. Richard T., born about 1836 in Morris County.
- 3. Julia A., born 1838 in Morris County.
- 4. Adeline Dency (shown as Dency in the 1850 census) was born 14 March 1840 in Morris, New Jersey; married George P. Roy; died 2 October 1832 in Parsippany, New Jersey.
- 5. James B., born 19 September 1842 in Randolph township, Morris County.
- 6. Sarah Emily, born 7 October 1849 in Chester, Morris County.

A biography of James Bowman gives this information: "A native of Morris county, he was born in Randolph township on the 19th of September, 1842, and is a son of Thomas BOWMAN, whose father, Nicholas BOWMAN, was descended from the old Dutch family of that name that was founded in New Jersey during the early days of American development. Thomas B OWMAN died in 1887, at the ripe old age of eighty-four year s. His wife, who bore the maiden name of Martha STOUT, was a daughter of Thomas B. STOUT, who was a tavern-keeper in Chester, in the early days of that village. Three children were born to Mr. and Mrs. BOWMAN, namely:

- (1) Richard T., of Morristown;
- (2) Adaline, who is the wife of George P. ROY, a farmer and a worthy citizen, of Mendham; and
- (3) James Briant BOWMAN, of this review.
