Louis immigrated to the United States in 1866, and Lucie in 1872. Louis was a naturalized citizen.

Lucie, age 19, is found on a ship's list for the SS Hansa on 25 June 1872. The ship originated in Bremen, Germany.

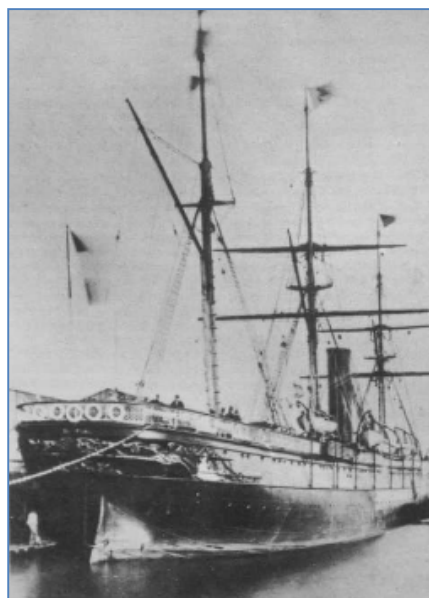

I, *E. Brückenstein* Master of the *S.S. Hansa* do solemnly, sincerely and truly that the following List or Manifest, subscribed by me, and now delivered by me to the Collector of the Customs of the Collection District of New-York, is a full and perfect list of all the passengers taken on board of the said *S.S. Hansa* at *Bremen* from which port said *Bremen* has now arrived; and that on said list is truly designated the age, the sex, and the occupation of each of said passengers, the part of the vessel occupied by each during the passage, the country to which each belongs, and also the country of which it is intended by each to become an inhabitant: and that said List or Manifest truly sets forth the number of said passengers who have died on said voyage, and the names and ages of those who died.

Sworn to this *25th* day of *June* 18*72* *E. Brückenstein* So help me God.

Before me *Wm. C. ...* *E. Brückenstein* Master of the *Bremen S.S. Hansa* whereof *...* is Master, from *Bremen* burthen *...* tons.
